Trustees are Honored

January is “School Board Recognition Month” for the State of Texas, and the Randolph Field ISD joined other districts in the state by recognizing its voluntary leadership. AT&T Contract Approved

A telecommunications contract, including basic telephone services and Internet access, was awarded to AT&T, deemed the best provider for the RFISD after requests for proposals were sought and evaluated.

Contract Approved for Search

Trustees approved a supplemental contract with Supt. Dr. Barbara Maddox for her to assist in the process of searching for a new superintendent for the district.

Cooperative Purchasing Participation Okayed

Trustees, upon recommendation by the Administration, adopted a resolution for participation in the Texas Assn. of School Board’s “TASB Buy” Board Purchasing Program, a voluntary association of local governments for purposes of cooperative purchasing of goods in order to obtain the best prices possible.
