A Summary of Actions of the Randolph Field ISD Board of Trustees

Meeting of Oct. 26, 2006

Final Construction Payment Okayed

Final payment to Peco Construction Co. for renovation work at Randolph Elementary School was approved by the district's Board of Trustees. The final contract cost for Phase 2 of the renovation work was \$1,979,498.33. The project included replacing all major systems such as electrical, water, and sewer, and remodeling all bathrooms, classrooms and offices. The project was funded from a Dept. of Education grant and a surety bond from the original contractor who declared bankruptcy.

New Basketball Handbook Approved

A new handbook for Ro-Hawk girls' basketball players that provides guidelines for such areas as practice attitude, training room rules, team goals, and guidelines for the locker room, equipment, laundry, weight room and team travel was approved by trustees.

Updates Given on Accountability, Curriculum

Updates concerning accountability and curriculum were presented to the Board of Rita Polen, executive director of instructional services. Polen reviewed with trustees a new chart that outlines the number of state tests that are administered annually to measure student progress and school effectiveness and how they all relate to one another. She then proceeded to give an overview of possible curriculum requirement changes in the future by the State Board of Education.

Randolph Middle School students and teacher Diane Hogan made a presentation to the Board concerning their experiences while attending the Challenger space center at Brooks AFB, then Board member Gene Quintanilla gave an overview of his recent attendance at the Texas School Administrators and Texas Association of School Boards convention in Houston.

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
