A Summary of Actions of the Randolph Field ISD Board of Trustees

Meeting of October 25, 2007

RFISD Receives Superior” Rating

The RFISD, for the fifth consecutive year, has been presented with a “Superior” rating under the Texas Schools First financial rating system. A public hearing concerning the financial accountability rating was conducted by the Board. The Texas School First program was established by the Texas Education agency in response to Senate Bill 875 that was passed by the Texas Legislature in 1999. The RFISD has never failed to receive the top rating offered.

District Fiscal Year Change Okayed

Trustees voted to change the district’s fiscal year to match it with the district’s school year. The fiscal year will now begin July 1 and end on June 30.

District Improvement Plan Approved

Also receiving approval from the Board was the District Improvement plan which is developed by, evaluated and revised by the District Wide Improvement Committee each year.

Investment Officer Added

Trustees also approved adding Supt. Billy Walker as a third district investment officer. Previously only the RFISD chief financial officer and Payroll Director were so designated.

No-Pass, No-Play Exemption Sought

Board members voted to request the Texas Education Agency to had pre-calculus as an exempt course under the “no pass-no play” regulations. Each year TEA allows school district to make recommendation for exempt courses.

New Teacher Hired

Trustees have approved the hiring of Sherrie Torres as a first grade teacher at Randolph Elementary School.
