# Committee

Rita Polen reviewed the District Effectiveness and Compliance indicators for Career and Technology with the committee. It was noted that many of the indicators have to do with the integration of Career and Technology with special education.

The business and technology teachers (Robert Lundy, Shirley Schulze, Lori Hurst and Pete Wesp) sent the committee a recommendation for modifying the existing Career and Technology plan. The modification would provide that Business Information Computer Systems would be the only technology class option for ninth grade students. The committee wanted to know if keyboarding was the major reason for the recommendation or if there were other concerns; they also wanted to know how many students were lacking in foundational skills. The committee will have further discussion on this topic at the next meeting.

The budget process was reviewed. It was noted that each year the district starts with a zero budget and builds the budget based on the needs of the students as indicated by teachers. At the next meeting Mr. Zepada will share information on the budget that is being prepared for the 2002-2003 school year.

A subcommittee was formed to revise the format used for the DWIC's written report to the Board of Trustees as well as the presentation of that summary report to the board.
