

## Districtwide Improvement Committee Minutes

May 17, 2005

David Gibbs and Ron Bolin discussed the use of Title II, Part D (Technology) monies for the 2005-2006 school year with the committee (teachers, administrators and parents). Ron noted that the technology personnel will be available for netSupport Schools training. There will be a week available during the 2006 summer for additional technology training for the staff as well. Input for this training will be gathered by the technology department prior to next summer so that they can provide the training needed by the staff.

Rita Polen reviewed the Title II (Migrant) identification process with the DWIC. Each year parents complete an information sheet on migrant students. Because RFISD serves students of military personnel, there are no migrant students in our schools. This information is collected each year and kept on file at each campus for the current school year.

The Title III Bilingual/ESL program was discussed by the committee. Randolph Field ISD belongs to the Education Service Center Shared Services Cooperative. Our ESL teachers as well as classroom teachers can attend training at Region 20 for no charge since the district is a member of the cooperative.

Rita Polen reviewed the Title IV Drug-Free and Violence-Free Schools program with DWIC. Again the district is a member of the Region 20 cooperative and through that cooperative teachers and administrators can attend training at Region 20. The service center completes the application for this program and also supports us throughout the year.

The Title V Innovative program is a means of supporting teachers as they develop their skills to enhance student learning. RFISD is a member of the ESC, Region 20, cooperative. This allows teachers to participate in staff development at Region 20 with no additional cost for the teachers.

Committee members discussed the summary report of the analysis of the District Effectiveness Survey. DWIC will look for ways to promote more responses to the survey from members especially for the CIC surveys. The district and campus are helping students to increase their achievement and to become successful, productive, responsible citizens.

The committee reviewed the tentative schedule for the Calendar for Completion of the Campus Improvement Process next year and changed the presentations by the campus committees to Wednesday, September 7. Further adjustments will be made as needed during the 2005-2006 school year.
