

Districtwide Improvement Committee Minutes

May 20, 2002

Laurel McCurdy and Carolyn Edwards shared information on the Title I program with the committee. Randolph Elementary has a targeted-assisted Title I reading program in grades one and two. Students who need additional help in reading are identified using the Texas Primary Reading Inventory, TPRI, and are provided intensive, daily support with Carolyn in first grade and Laurel in second grade. Parents are encouraged to support their students reading through their participation in Parent Reading Academies and through reading with their children each evening.

The Title II Teacher and Principal Training and Recruiting program was reviewed with DWIC. The \$19,000 provided through this program is used for staff development that included consultants sharing their expertise with the staff on technology, brain research and mathematics.

David Gibbs noted that there would be major changes in the requirements to meet federal program standards with the passing of the No Child Left Behind legislation. These new requirements will be addressed throughout next year as more information becomes available.

As a member of the DWIC subcommittee, Maggie Napper shared the recommendations to revise the DWIC Summary and the presentation to the Board of Trustees with the committee. The revisions were approved by the committee and will be in place for the September report to the board.

The fall schedule for the DWIC meetings was presented and approved by the committee.
