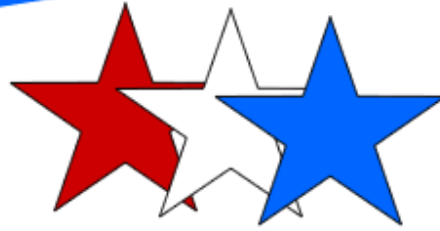

## *Overview*

# **RANDOLPH FIELD ISD DISTRICT IMPROVEMENT PLAN**

## **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this document is to meet the accountability requirements of the Texas Education Code §11.252 that requires each school district to have a District Improvement Plan that is developed, evaluated, and revised annually and must include the provisions listed in this section of the law.

## **RATIONALE:**

The Randolph Field ISD has in place a planning process that contains all of the required provisions of a district improvement plan. While the process is multifaceted and does not contain all components in a single document, the process is achieving the desired results.

The Randolph Field ISD has been successful in educating the students in each of the schools in the district. The Texas Education Agency Accountability System rated the district as exemplary for the 2010-2011 school year.

## **DISTRICT GOALS:**

**The ultimate goal for Randolph Field ISD is to increase student achievement for all students.**

Randolph Field ISD has adopted these goals based on significant information about the district with student achievement above the state expectations. The district has determined that although students have been meeting state requirements, they have not all met the standards of the nation and world in which they must compete upon graduation.

The District Mission, Vision and Commitments, along with the District Instructional Goals and Activities guide all facets of the district planning process. As the initial action in curriculum planning, community members, parents and staff worked to define the mission and the core competencies. Teachers and administrators throughout the district collectively developed the vision and established those actions to which everyone will commit. Subsequently the district developed the District Instructional Goals and Activities that reflect both the purpose and the competencies, support the district vision, and provide the foundation for the desired increase in student achievement:

- GOAL #1:** Ensure 100% of Randolph Field ISD students meet Satisfactory Academic Performance on the state assessment for each assessed curriculum area.
  
- GOAL #2:** Ensure Randolph Field ISD students remain at or above the state average for the Advanced Academic Performance indicator for each assessed curriculum area.
  
- GOAL #3:** Provide a well balanced and challenging curriculum that allows students to access and process information, solve problems and communicate working as individuals and team members, using technology to facilitate student learning.
