

Annual Performance Report on Violence in Schools and the Drug – Free Schools And Communities Evaluation

August 25, 2011

Randolph Field ISD provides students and all staff members with a safe and drug-free environment. The district staff not only intervenes when there is a safety or drug issue, but they provide students with the means to prevent violence and abstain from drugs.

Classroom teachers utilize the Drug and Violence Education program provided by the state of Texas to teach students about being drug-free and to find ways to deal with anger other than violence. Counselors go into classrooms emphasizing being drug-free and teaching students ways to resolve disputes without resorting to violence.

Randolph Field ISD has specific policies and procedures on violence outlined in the Student Code of Conduct. Students and parents receive a copy of this document at the beginning of each school year and the document is available on the RFISD website. The consequences of school violence whether it is fighting with another student, having an altercation with a teacher or damaging property are described in this code of conduct. Any incident of violence on the campus is reported to the administration. An investigation occurs and the appropriate consequences are prescribed once the incident is verified.

There were 3 referrals for fighting at the elementary campus for 2010-2011 and 0 referrals in 2009-2010. There was 1 referral for fighting in middle school during 2010-2011 and 0 referrals in 2009-2010. The high school had 0 referrals for fighting last year and 1 referral in 2009-2010. There were 2 reported acts of violation of the student code of conduct at the high school and no use of weapons in the district.

There were 0 reported incidents of tobacco, alcohol or drug use at the elementary or middle school and 3 reports at the high school in 2010-2011. In 2009-2010 there were no reported incidents of tobacco, alcohol or drug use at the elementary, middle school and high school. This information, as well as the information on violence, was reported in the Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities Program Annual Evaluation Report for the school year 2010-2011. Randolph Field ISD's goals are to maintain -0- incidents of drugs, alcohol and tobacco use and to decrease the number of fights that are occurring.
