

PROOF OF IDENTITY FORM
State Registration Requirements

Under state law, a parent or guardian with custody **must furnish proof of a child's identity upon registration.** This may be in the form of:

- _____ Birth Certificate
- _____ Military ID
- _____ Passport
- _____ Documentation not available at Registration

A parent or other person with custody of a child enrolling a child in a public school has 30 days (from day of registration to provide proof of the child's identity.)

If the documentation required is not furnished to the district within the time provided, the district, by law, must notify the police department of the county in which the district is located and request a determination of whether the child has been reported as missing.

Presenting a false document or false records is an offense under Section 37.10 of the Penal Code, and that enrollment of the child under false documents subjects the person to liability for tuition or costs under Section 21.031 of this code.
