

STATE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

Under state law, a parent or guardian w/ custody must furnish proof of a child's identity upon registration. This may be in the form of:

birth certificate

or

Passport

A parent or other person with custody of a child, enrolling a child in a public school, has 30 days (from the day of registration) to provide proof of the child's identity. If the information required is not furnished to the district within the time provided, the district, by law, must notify the police department of the county in which the district is located and request a determination of whether the child has been reported as missing.

Presenting a false document or false records is an offense under Section 37.10 of the Penal Code, and that enrollment of the child under false documents subjects the person to liability for tuition or costs under Section 21.031 of this code.

As required by the 1992-93 Data Standard for School District Data Delivery in the state of Texas, School Districts will submit the data required by the 1992-93 PEIMS Data Standards to their ESC's in accordance with the satisfactions provided in this section. Every student served by the district is to be reported, except for adult basic and secondary education, adult vocational education, and nonpublic school (private or parochial) students. Student ID is either the student's Social Security number or a state-approved alternative student identification number.
