

SPC MEETING
November 29, 2006
Minutes

Rita Polen reviewed the Curriculum Criteria Subcommittee report. SPC agreed to train a group of teachers in the evaluation of performance tasks in the spring of 2007, and then implement the use of the criteria in the fall of 2007. The committee currently consists of Dabs Hollimon, Beth Howard, Rita Polen, and Allana Hemenway (other members have left the district). New members were added to the subcommittee: Dick Wilson and Charlie Phillips.

Research Skills Committee members, Rita Polen and Roger Ruder, shared information regarding the Long Range Plan for Research Skills Subcommittee. They indicated the subcommittee's work has been completed with the exception of refining the MLA format for the elementary campus. The MLA format should be included in the scope and sequence under "other resources". The subcommittee will be placed on hiatus until it is needed at a later time.

SPC members were invited to make recommendations regarding the calendar for 2007-08. They were also invited to volunteer to serve on the District Calendar Committee. Recommendations included: continue one week of staff development/work days prior to beginning of school; avoid Saturday work day during the school year; continue week of vacation at Thanksgiving.

Next meeting of the SPC is March 21. The agenda will include discussion of necessary revisions of the scope and sequence format and presentations of work on the scope and sequence from each campus. In addition, we will make recommendations for the next step of the curriculum project for the upcoming school year.
